Applicant must be no less than 18 years of age or more than 35 years of age, at time of appointment.

Applicant must be physically fit to perform all the duties associated with the position of police officers and must be eligible for inclusion in the New Jersey State Police and Firemen's Retirement System (PFRS).

Applicant must be of good moral character and have a record free of convictions of any crime, indictable offense, or any crime or offense involving moral turpitude.

Applicants must either have graduated from a NJ PTC academy and be eligible for a NJ PTC BCPO certificate, a waiver eligible SLEO II, or enrolled in a NJ PTC alternate route course graduating before 06/30/2023
