ORDINANCE #23-06

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE, COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY APPROVING A FINANCIAL AGREEMENT WITH ALLENDALE URBAN RENEWAL, LP

WHEREAS, the Borough Council (the "Borough Council") of the Borough of Allendale (the "Borough"), a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, is authorized pursuant to the Long Term Exemption Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:20-1 <u>et seq</u>. (the "Tax Exemption Law"), to enter into financial agreements with urban renewal entities for low and moderate income projects; and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2023, the Borough, pursuant to Resolution#23-93, authorized the private sale of that certain real property known and designated as Block 1708, Lots 1 and 9, on the Tax Map of the Borough (the "Property"), to Allendale Urban Renewal, LP (the "Entity") an urban renewal entity formed and qualified to do business under the provisions of the Tax Exemption Law, and formed for the purpose of <u>inter alia</u>, initiating and conducting low and moderate incoming housing projects; and

WHEREAS, the Entity has been undertaking a low and moderate income housing project, which qualifies as a Qualified Subsidized Housing Project, located at the Property and shall continue to undertake such low and moderate income housing project at the Property subsequent to its acquisition of the Property (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Entity has applied in March 2023 to the Borough Council for tax emption pursuant to the Exemption Law with respect to the Project (the "Exemption Application"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds that the tax exemption requested by the Entity in the Exemption Application will benefit the Borough and its inhabitants by the operation of low and moderate income housing project at the Property, and that the benefits would substantially outweigh the costs, if any, associated with tax exemptions; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds that the requested tax exemptions are important to the Borough and that without the incentives of the tax exemptions the Project would not be undertaken; and

WHEREAS, as part of its Exemption Application the Entity has submitted a form of Financial Agreement (the "Financial Agreement") providing for payments in lieu of taxes, incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Entity has presented to this body certain information, copies of which are attached as exhibits to the Financial Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council deems it to be in the best interest of the Borough to pass an Ordinance authorizing the Borough to enter into the proposed Financial Agreement with the Entity on the terms and conditions stated in the form of the Financial Agreement submitted by the Entity; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:20-8, the Mayor has reviewed the Exemption Application and the Mayor has submitted the Exemption Application and Financial Agreement to the Borough Council with her recommendation for approval, subject to the condition that the Entity pay, in lieu of tax payments on the Project, an annual service charge as provided herein; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the proposed Project, the Exemption Application and the Mayor's recommendation, the Borough has made the following findings with respect to the Project pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A</u> 40A:20-11:

1. The Project will benefit the Borough and its residents by the continued operation of low and moderate income housing on the Land; and

2. The Financial Agreement was a material inducement to the Entity to acquire the Property and facilitate the further operation of low and moderate income housing on the Property; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Exemption Law, the Borough desires to authorize the execution of the Financial Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Project is hereby approved for the grant of a tax exemption under the Exemption Law by virtue of, pursuant to, and in conformity with the provisions of the Exemption Law.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Financial Agreement with the Entity in substantially the form referenced herein, and subject to any further review, analysis or modifications that Borough counsel may deem appropriate. The Borough Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to the execution of the Financial Agreement by the authorized officers of the Borough as determined hereunder, and to affix the corporate seal of the Borough to the Financial Agreement.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Financial Agreement is not to be signed until the Entity has received from the Borough the executed deed conveying title to the Property to the Entity.

<u>Section 4.</u> The Office of the Borough Clerk shall forthwith file certified copies of this Ordinance and the Financial Agreement with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:20-12.

<u>Section 5.</u> Upon the execution of the Financial Agreement as contemplated herein, either the Entity or the Borough (through its Authorized Officers and the Borough Clerk) may file and record this Ordinance and the Financial Agreement with the Bergen County Clerk such that the Financial Agreement and this Ordinance shall be reflected upon the land records of the County of Bergen as a lien upon and a covenant running with the land constituting the Property.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest possible time as permitted by and in accordance with all applicable laws.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Allendale had retained Z+ Architects to provide architectural services for the new Borough Community Recreation Center located at 220 West Crescent Avenue, Block 1005, Lot 20 via Resolution 22-216 on September 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Allendale has a need for additional services with Z + Architects for Construction Documents for Public Bid for Allendale Community Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, it is not anticipated that the scope and cost of services will exceed Ninety Thousand (\$90,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, Z + Architects of Allendale, New Jersey, has submitted a proposal dated February 24, 2023; and

Dear Mayor Wilczynski:

We look forward to getting the project design and documentation completed, publically bid and under construction. As discussed, the town's change in direction to bid this project publically will require an enhanced set of Construction Documents to a level of detail that differs from what our previous contract with Hamsphire accounted for. This new proposal details out the additional work, time and fee that will be required to prepare a set suitable for a public bid as detailed below. Additionally, it includes our time to develop a Kitchen Design and related specifications by consulting with a Commercial Kitchen consultant.

Our fees related to the Public Biding process and Construction Observation, will be detailed out in a separate contract.

- 4. Services will be billed every 30 days as a percentage of phase completion.
- 5. Payment of all invoices are due prior to release of signed and sealed plans or final deliverables. No exceptions will be made to this policy.
- 6. Colored renderings included in the scope of work as mentioned in Design Development above are limited to exterior concepts. Interior renderings, virtual walk-throughs, and any other use of the 3D model for interior concepts can be provided, as an additional process, at the owner's request.
- 7. The retainer will be held until the completion of Architectural Services for this project. The retainer will be applied after issuance of the final invoice for the project. Any overage that results will then be refunded back in the form of a check. The retainer will not be applied to any invoices, other than the final invoice. No partial application of the retainer will be made to any invoices.
- 8. Z+ Architects maintains the intellectual rights to the work, and the designs generated in this process may not be taken to another firm and used by them to create documents for construction, without negotiating such with our permission. Should the owner decide to not execute the build of the design, and/or relocate to another property, the design is non-transferrable to another property and/or subsequent owner, without written permission from Z+ Architects.
