ORDINANCE #23-08

CALENDAR YEAR 2023 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% or the cost of living adjustment, whichever is less, unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of living adjustment for calendar year 2023

budget is calculated at 2.5% pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2023 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby determines that a 1.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$103,549 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2023 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Allendale shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by up to 3.5%, amounting to \$362,421, and that the CY 2023 municipal budget for the Borough of Allendale be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

APPROVAL FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF SEASONAL SNOW REMOVAL FOR YEARS 2021 AND 2022 PER THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE AGREEMENT OF FEBRUARY 11, 2021 TO THE WHITNEY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

WHEREAS, The Whitney Homeowners Association, Inc. (the "Association"), a not for profit corporation of the State of New Jersey, is responsible for the administration and management of the common areas and facilities at the residential development located within the Borough of Allendale (the "Borough") known as The Whitney (hereinafter referred to as the "Development"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with New Jersey's Municipal Services Act (hereinafter referred to as the "**Act**"), L.1989, C. 299 (*N.J.S.A.* 40:67-23.1 <u>et seq.</u>), the Borough is required either to perform certain specified services on roads and streets in the Development, which is a qualified private community, or to reimburse the Association to the extent specified in that statute for the actual costs to the Association of providing said specified services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and the Association have agreed that during the 2020-2021 Winter Season, the amount for services was \$15,970.00, during the 2021-2022 Winter Season, the amount for services was \$11,900.00, totaling \$27,870.00 due to The Whitney at Allendale.

WHEREAS, the Borough's Chief Financial Officer has affirmed that the Borough has sufficient available funds for the foregoing payment for Prior Municipal Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough's Chief Financial be and hereby is authorized to make such payment to the Association in the sum of \$27,870.00.

ADOPTION OF UPDATED PERSONNEL POLICIES & PROCEDURES MANUAL/EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Borough of Allendale to treat employees and prospective employees in a manner consistent with all applicable employment laws and regulations including, but not limited to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended by the Equal Opportunity Act of 1972, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, the Equal Pay for Equal Work Act, the Fair Labor Standards Act, the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Family and Medical Leave Act, the Conscientious Employee Protection Act, the Public Employee Occupational Safety and Health Act, the New Jersey Attorney General's guidelines with respect to Police Department personnel matters, the New Jersey Workers Compensation Act, the Federal Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) and the Open Public Meeting Act; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that there is a need for personnel policies and procedures to ensure that employees and prospective employees are treated in a manner consistent with these laws and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale that the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual is hereby adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these personnel policies and procedures shall apply to all Borough of Allendale officials, appointees, employees, volunteers and independent contractors. In the event there is a conflict between these rules and any collective bargaining agreement, personnel services contract or Federal or State law, the terms and conditions of that contract or law shall prevail. In all other cases, these policies and procedures shall prevail.

The provisions of this manual may be amended and supplemented from time to time without notice and at the sole discretion of the Mayor and Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the maximum extent permitted by law, employment practices for the Borough of Allendale shall operate under the legal doctrine known as "employment at will."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Administration, Finance and HR Committee and all managerial/supervisory personnel are responsible for these employment practices. The Administrative Officer and the Municipal/Labor Attorney shall assist the Administration, Finance and HR Committee in the implementation of the policies and procedures in the manual.

It is the intention of our organizations to add four (4) new senior units at Cebak Court. We have already retained an Architect, Engineer and General Contractor.
