A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR AMY WILCZYNSKI

Spring is here, and the Borough is hard at work getting Allendale ready for the upcoming season. After a particularly snowy winter, the cleanup has required a bit of extra effort including significant pothole repairs. Our DPW team has been working full force to get the Borough 'spring ready.'

Crestwood Lake is being prepped for another great season! This year, we are excited to welcome a **new concessionaire** and look forward to meeting them and officially welcoming them to the Allendale community. We will also be holding a delayed **ribbon-cutting ceremony**, since we did not have the opportunity to do so last year.

Our **athletic fields** are looking amazing and will be ready for Opening Day later this month. **Fields 3, 4 (Kunisch), 5, and 6 were redone** last year, and this year our work continues with **improvements to Grandstand and Fields 1 and 2**. We received a **\$45,000 grant towards these improvements!**

We also worked very hard on our budget this year and are pleased to report that municipal taxes will increase by **less than 1%**! Our tax rate has DECREASED for the 6th year in a row with this year's decrease as the highest, at 10%. We are proud to share that Allendale has the **lowest average tax impact in surrounding NW Bergen County**, which range from 2-16%. This success is the result of sound planning, careful spending throughout the year, and our commitment to pursuing every grant opportunity available to us. A sincere thank you to our **CFO, Alison Altano**, for her tireless vigilance and dedication to keeping our budget lean for the benefit of our taxpayers. We will be adopting the budget at the **April 23rd Council Meeting beginning at 7:00 PM**, and **we encourage residents to attend!**

At our last Council Meeting, we had the pleasure of celebrating Allendale alongside our police officers after **being named one of the safest towns in America**. It was a well-deserved moment of recognition and pride for our entire community.

As part of our **250th themed year**, Allendale will also be **recognized as a "Victory Town"** for its historical significance as a vital corridor for the Continental Army's march in 1781, providing supplies that were essential to achieving America's independence.

We have also been working hard to organize a **parade** that will lead into the **Holiday Observers 250th event on September 19th**. We encourage all residents and merchants to join in the celebration by **creating a float** and marching with us. More details to come!

Save the date - **Congressman Josh Gottheimer** will be in Allendale on **May 19th at 6 pm** at the community center to answer any questions you may have on a state and federal level. Our **2nd Town Hall will immediately follow at 7 pm**.

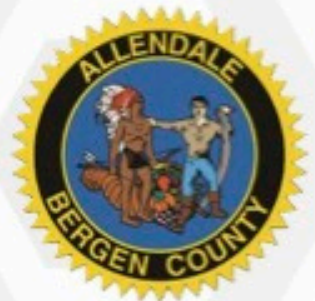

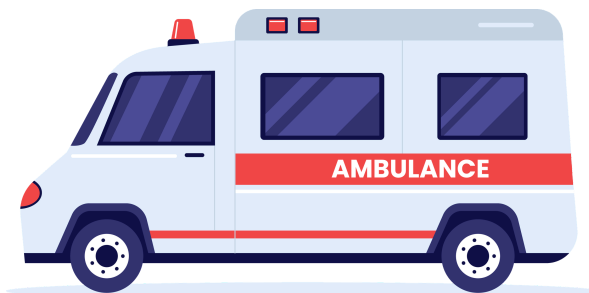
