- Old T-Shirts – Used for oil paint rags
- Craft materials – Ribbons, Beads, etc.
- Fabric swatches

Batteries Recycled at Staples

- Alkaline, Rechargeable and Button Batteries
- NiCad and Lithium tool batteries
- PLEASE - NO Vehicle Batteries!
- Note that Staples has an extensive recycling and rewards program which provides significant savings towards purchases

Clothing – Clean and Odorless but in any wear condition - Repurposed or Recycled Through Helpsy

- Footwear – ALL types
- Accessories – Hats, Bags, Belts, Gloves, Ties and Scarves, Jewelry
- Luggage and Stuffed Animals
- Clothing – ALL types including undergarments
- Linens – Sheets, Blankets, Comforters, Tablecloths, Napkins

Electronics – Collected at Recycling Center Walk-In Container

- Desktop and Laptop Computers, Phones, Tablets, Printers, Accessories, Charges, Cables
- Stereo Equipment
- Small Appliances – Toasters, Microwaves, Blenders, etc.
- Window Air Conditioners
- Flat Screen TVs and Flat Computer Monitors

- PLEASE – NO large appliances, NO Tube Televisions or Tube Computer Screens

EPS #6 Packing “styrofoam” – Densified and Recycled by Ridgewood DPW

- Clean, Dry, White Packing Foam Only (Please do not store your material outdoors)
- We cannot accept marked, soiled, wet or otherwise contaminated material
- Please remove labels and tape and check that coolers are empty
- NO Soft Foam – The correct material will snap when you bend it
- NO Food Contact Foam – NO Egg Cartons, No Cups or Plates

Paper Shredding – Service provided by Bergen County Utilities Authority

- PLEASE limit shredding to confidential and sensitive documents only
- NO books, magazines, newspapers, etc.
- REMOVE heavy metal clips and metal hanging folders
- It is NOT necessary to remove paper clips, staples or paperboard binder covers.

Plastic Bags – NexTrex recycling program

- YES – Pallet stretch film, Grocery bags, Bread bags, Product wrap from water bottles & toilet tissue & paper towels, Cereal box liners, Newspaper sleeves, Dry cleaning bags, Produce bags, Ziploc bags, Air pillows, Bubble wrap, Plastic shipping envelopes, Ice bags, Six pack can rings.
- NO – Wet, Dirty, Food Soiled Material
- NO – Frozen Food Bags, Candy Wrappers, Net or Mesh Produce Bags, Chip Bags, Pet Food Bags, Pre-washed Salad Bags, Hot Dog or Meat Wrap, Bedding or Linen Packaging
- NO – Shiny, Crinkly Films like Floral Wrap

Reusable Bags and Food – Center for Food Action in Mahwah

- PLEASE – Gently used and preferably folded Reusable Shopping Bags
- NO – Dirty, Soiled, Broken bags
- Non-Perishable Food Donations and Hygiene Necessities

Syringes and Rx Medications – Valley Hospital & Allendale Police Department

- Syringes (sharps) – Any needles used for injection of medication
- Rx Medications – Expired or Unused prescription medications

X-Ray and MRI films – Recycled for their silver content

- Recycler is Hipaa certified for patient privacy and EPA certified for recycling
