## Solid Waste & Recycling Curbside Regulations & Schedule

Allendale is going dual stream! What does this mean???

Starting January 1, 2015 Allendale is improving its recycling program by introducing a simple, efficient way to recycle:

**ONLY 2 containers -2x a month- Both on the same day!**

#### **ONE Container ALL HOUSEHOLD PAPER**

##### **WHAT DOES THIS INCLUDE?**

- Newspaper & inserts
  - Cardboard boxes/press board
  - Cereal, pasta, tissue boxes, toilet paper roll, paper towel roll
  - Junk mail, envelopes, office paper, construction paper
  - Brown paper bags
  - Magazines, catalogs, phone books, soft covered books
  - Shredded paper
  - Empty and unsoiled pizza boxes
  - Non-metallic wrapping paper and greeting cards
- Please use collection containers no larger than 30 gallons.

##### **Items NOT ACCEPTABLE**

- Paper soiled with grease, paint, etc.
- Wax coated paper
- Hard covered books (if the covers are removed, then acceptable to recycle)

#### **ONE Container COMMINGLE**

##### **WHAT IS COMMINGLE RECYCLING?**

- Plastic containers with a recycling code 1-7
  - Aluminum cans, foil
  - Metal cans and empty aerosol cans
  - Green, clear and brown glass bottles and jars
  - Aseptic packaging (ex: soup, milk containers)
- All food containers should be rinsed and cleaned of debris prior to disposal.

##### **Items NOT ACCEPTABLE**

- Ceramic plates and cups
- All Styrofoam
- Window glass and table tops
- Cookware – pots, pans, bowls, utensils
- Plastic bags, plastic wrap and plastic film
- Toothpaste
- Wire hangers (this is scrap metal or should be returned to drycleaner)

### **WHEN IS RECYCLING PICKUP?**

Every other Thursday depending if you live on East side or West side of town (see insert for dates)

### **WHAT ABOUT THE BOY SCOUT PAPER DRIVE?**

In addition to including your newspaper in the recycling pick up dates, the Boy Scouts will continue to pick up on designated Saturdays (see insert for dates)

**PLEASE REMEMBER DO NOT PLACE ANY ITEMS IN PLASTIC BAGS!!**

What **CAN** be dropped off? Items that make \$\$\$\$ -

- Commingled recyclables – **loose**, not in plastic bags
- Cardboard – place in garbage truck
- Junk mail, magazines, newspapers – **loose**, not in plastic bags or tied
- Soft covered books, remove hard covers
- Office paper, shredded paper – **loose**, not in plastic bags or tied
- Clothing/textiles – sheets, blankets, table cloths

What **CANNOT** be dropped off?

- household garbage
- bulky trash
- scrap metal
- tires
- automobile batteries
- hazardous waste
- plastic bags, plastic film, plastic wrapping
- electronic waste such as TVs or computers

## MOVING?

Gently used items can be donated. Visit the borough website at [www.allendalenj.gov](http://www.allendalenj.gov) for a listing of charities that accept these items.

Two weeks prior to closing, call 201 818-4410 to schedule a pick-up and we'll notify the contractor. This collection will coincide with your regular garbage collection. Items that are recyclable will not be collected. Please bring them to the Recycling Center. This is a one-time only collection, please schedule accordingly.

## SCRAP METAL COLLECTION

The fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month for BOTH sides of the borough.

Items acceptable for curbside metal collection are:

- Bicycles
- Refrigerators\* remove the doors
- Washers and dryers
- Cast iron
- Radiators
- BBQ grills – minus the propane tank
- Anything that is at least 75% metal.

\*appliances such as refrigerators, air conditioners, etc., containing "Freon or CDC's" must be certified that the Freon and CDC's have been removed by a certified person or vendor and that a sticker (supplied by the removal company) is attached to the appliance. This is required by law!

All grass, leaves and brush are accepted with a resident compost permit. Permits can be purchased at Borough Hall, Monday – Friday 9:00am – 3:30pm.

Call 201-818-4400 ext 200 for more information.

No plastic bags allowed, please use brown biodegradable bags or place in container to transport grass and leaves. **NO LANDSCAPERS OR CONTRACTORS** are allowed.

**CUT-IT-AND-LEAVE-IT:** Recycling your own grass is easy and saves you, and the town, money. Use a mulching lawnmower or replace the blade with a mulching blade. When you cut your grass, allow it to remain on the ground to be reabsorbed and provide vital nutrients to your grass. You save time by not having to bag the grass and transport it to the Compost Site. You won't have to use as much fertilizer and the cut grass helps reduce water evaporation so you use less water.

## GARBAGE COLLECTION

Suburban Disposal, under a contract with the municipality, performs curbside household garbage collection for both the EAST and WEST side of the borough. The NJ Transit Railroad divides the borough. No receptacles shall be set out prior to 6:00pm on the night before collection and shall be removed by 9:00pm on the day of collection. Please use containers no larger than 30 gallons. Please refrain from calling if your garbage is not collected by its "normal" time. A number of things, including weather, truck break downs, detours, etc. may occur that could detain the contractor from collecting the route. The contractor has until 6:00pm to finish the route.
