e look forward to another great season at beautiful Crestwood Lake!

Each year we strive to think of ways to improve Crestwood Lake while maintaining the beautiful and natural feel of the lake. We have added many new features over the past years including, ADA Mobi Mats, a slide and swimming docks (all through grants). We also added beautiful landscaping as you enter the park, a pavilion and kayaks. This year we are building a band shell and next year we will be putting in a new playground - all through grants.

About 5 years ago, we started treating the lake with a new organic agent. We no longer have the large algae mats that float down the lake toward the end of the season. Our new organic agent naturally eliminates the algae and the water has never been cleaner! We've upgraded our pumps and we added aerators- it's a much cleaner, healthier and efficient way of treating the lake.



In celebration of the borough's 125th anniversary, there will be a slideshow presentation "Allendale - Now and Then" by Joanne Hart, 6th generation "Allendonian" and President of the Allendale Historical Society. The presentation will be at the May 9th Mayor and Council meeting at 8pm. Refreshments will be served.

Before the Borough purchased the lake over 40 years ago, it was a recreational swimming facility for all of NJ. Currently the lake is membership only and consists of approximately 80% Allendale residents and 20% non-Allendale residents. Non-Allendale residents must have an Allendale lake member as a sponsor in order to join. The only exception is if you are from the Northern Highlands sending district (Upper Saddle River, Saddle River & Ho HoKus).

The lake is financially healthy and its operations are run entirely on membership fees.

This year Allendale celebrates 125 years as a Borough. We have a wonderful expanded schedule of concerts through our 'Events at the Lake' concert series in celebration. These events are open to all. It's so nice to see residents relax and unwind with their feet in the sand while listening to great music.

Crestwood Lake is commonly referred to as our 'town jewel' and we certainly think it is.
