**ORDINANCE 20-23**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL IN ITS ENTIRETY §26-30.3 OF  
CHAPTER 26 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF  
ALLENDALE, AND AMEND, SUPPLEMENT AND REVISE §26-  
31(D) OF THE BOROUGH CODE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that §26-31(D) of the Code of the Borough of Allendale, be and hereby is amended, supplemented and revised in its entirety to read as follows:


D. Rates of compensations; administrative fee; payment for services. Rates of compensation for contracting the services of off-duty law enforcement officers shall be based on a rate equal to that of time and ½ of the contractual hourly rate for the individual officer being compensated. An additional fee of 25% of the rate as calculated above is hereby established to cover administrative costs, overhead, and out-of-pocket expenses of the Borough. Payment for the use of any motor vehicle of the Police Department in connection with the services of off-duty law enforcement officers of the Allendale Police Department authorized in this §26-31 shall be \$125 per day, or any part of a day, provided however, that the Chief of Police shall have the authority to waive such fee for the use of a police vehicle if, in his or her discretion, the use of a police vehicle shall not result in any material wear and tear of such vehicle.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that §26-30.3 of the Borough Code be, and hereby is, repealed in its entirety.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, except as modified herein, all other provisions of Chapter 26 of the Borough Code shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted.
