**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Allendale intends to participate in the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) Cooperative contract, Proposal EP11-17, Contract EE08-19 to purchase 3M Scott SCBA equipment for the Allendale Fire Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, information regarding the contract may be found at Allendale Borough Hall, 500 West Crescent Avenue, Allendale, NJ 07401 during regular business hours, as well as on the Borough of Allendale's website at: [www.allendalenj.gov](http://www.allendalenj.gov); and,

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Allendale is a member of H-GAC; and,

**WHEREAS**, the H-GAC contract period is through October 31, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the Borough of Allendale to make a contract award to New Jersey Fire Equipment, 119-131 Route 22 East, Green Brook, New Jersey 08812, pursuant to the proposal submitted in response to the Borough's specifications; and;

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Allendale is permitted to join national cooperative purchasing agreements under the authority of N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(b)(3).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Allendale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that the Acting Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to publish the forgoing, enumerated "Notice of Intent to Award a Contract Under a National Cooperative Purchasing Agreement" in the legal newspaper of the Borough of Allendale with a comment period to end at the close of business hours on Tuesday, September 1, 2020.

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ASSEMBLY BILL A108 AND ACCOMPANYING  
SENATE BILL S2473 TO IMPROVE SERVICE PERFORMANCE BY PUBLIC  
UTILITY COMPANIES IN THE PUBLIC'S INTEREST**

**WHEREAS**, the citizens and businesses of the State of New Jersey rely on public utility companies (public utilities) for the provision of essential services such as electricity, natural gas, sewer and water; and

**WHEREAS**, public utilities in the State of New Jersey are regulated by the Board of Public Utilities (BPU); and

**WHEREAS**, a public utility, as part of their application process, must comply with federal, state and local laws as well as rules and regulations and terms and conditions prior to the BPU's approval of a public utility privilege or franchise (franchise); and

**WHEREAS**, the political subdivisions of the State of New Jersey (municipalities) award franchise agreements to public utilities for the provision of such services that the BPU has determined to be necessary and proper for the public convenience and in the public interest; and

**WHEREAS**, the current franchise approval process and related laws are outdated and are no longer properly serving the public convenience or interest; and

**WHEREAS**, Assembly Bill A108, sponsored by Assemblymen DePhillips (D40), Rooney (D40) and Johnson (D37) and unanimously passed by the Assembly Telecommunications Committee in October 2018, seeks to revise and update the public utility franchise process and proposes changes to increase accountability and allow municipalities to explore options and seek alternate solutions to better protect the public's interest including revoking the franchise if/when the public utility violates terms of the agreement or inadequately provides for continuous and uninterrupted service; and

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill S2473, sponsored by Senator Corrado (D40), is the accompanying Senate legislation to Assembly Bill A108; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of a municipality to act in the interests of and as the voice of the citizens of their community.



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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Body of the Borough of Allendale hereby appeals to the New Jersey Legislature to pass Assembly Bill A108 and Senate Bill S2473, in the interest of the citizens of the Borough of Allendale as well as the State of New Jersey, to ensure that their utility needs are met; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to Senator Kristin Corrado, Assemblymembers Kevin Rooney, Christopher DePhillips and Gordon Johnson, Senate President Stephen Sweeney, Assembly Speaker Craig Coughlin, Governor Philip Murphy, the Municipal Clerks Association of New Jersey and the New Jersey State League of Municipalities.
