§ 181-1. Short-term rental property.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Borough Code, it shall be unlawful for any person, including, but not limited to, an owner, lessor, or sublessor with any possessory interest in any dwelling, property, or facility to receive compensation of any kind for the use, occupancy, or rental of any dwelling, property or facility, including but not limited to pools, cabanas, driveways and playgrounds, for a period of 30 days or less. The foregoing provisions shall not be applicable to any dwelling, property or facility owned by the Borough of Allendale, or located within the following zone districts within the Borough of Allendale: E, EM, D1, D2, C1 and C2.

Except as modified herein, all other provisions of Chapter 181 shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted.
