RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, DESIGNATING \$3,063,210 OF NOTES CONSISTING OF \$2,713,210 GENERAL BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES AND \$350,000 WATER UTILITY BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES, BOTH ISSUES DATED SEPTEMBER 26, 2019, PAYABLE SEPTEMBER 25, 2020, AS "QUALIFIED TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATIONS" PURSUANT TO SECTION 265(b)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Allendale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") intends to issue \$3,063,210 of notes consisting of \$2,713,210 General Bond Anticipation Notes and

\$350,000 Water Utility Bond Anticipation Notes, both issues dated September 26, 2019, payable September 25, 2020 (the "Notes"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to designate the Notes as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Allendale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Notes are hereby designated as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" for the purpose of Section 265(b)(3) of the Code.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said Notes are not "private activity bonds" as defined in the Code and (2) the Borough and its subordinate entities, if any, do not reasonably anticipate issuing in excess of \$10 million of new money tax-exempt obligations (other than private activity bonds) during the calendar year 2019.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. It is further determined and stated that the Borough has, as of the date hereof, issued the following tax-exempt obligations (other than the Notes) during the calendar year 2019:

<u>SECTION 4</u>. The Borough will, to the best of its ability, attempt to comply with respect to the limitations on issuance of tax-exempt obligations pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code; however, said Borough does not covenant to do so, and hereby expressly states that a covenant is not made hereby.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. The issuing officers of the Borough are hereby authorized to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the original purchaser of the Notes and to further provide such original purchaser with a certificate of obligations issued during the calendar year 2019 dated as of the date of delivery of the Notes.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
